



POLICY AGREEMENT FOR FAIR- TRADE PURCHASES

Overview

Jambohut is a 100% fair trade company. This is never negotiable.

Jambohut shall always exceed the criteria of F.I.N.E. and lead by example.

Implementation, Aims & Objectives

1. That purchases are only made from bona-fide co-operatives and approved, where appropriate by the Commercial Co-operative Union for the country.
2. That 100% of the purchase price was available to the members of the co-operative.
3. That the operating society committee can retain 10%, (or more as agreed in open meeting with members and Jambohut) to help running costs but that such costs be accountable and verifiable.
4. That 90%,(or less as agreed in open meeting with members and Jambohut) of the purchase price is paid directly to the contributing members.
5. That we have divulged the UK wholesale and retail prices at the time of the first order being placed, the cost of shipping to the UK with insurance and we agreed that the cost purchase price was fair and a reasonable proportion of the selling price.
6. We agree to review the prices annually.
7. We, the purchasers, agreed to spend an additional sufficient sum received from sales on investing in sustainable planting

of indigenous softwoods e.g. Jacaranda, in land that we agreed could be set aside for such planting.

8. We, the purchasers, agreed to spend an additional 10% of cost on investing in Social development, (the Community Fund), to enhance the living standards for members and their families.
9. We further agree that 3 new renewable trees should be planted for every one cut for product manufacture.
10. We further agree that no child labour shall be used
11. We further agree that no discrimination on the grounds of sex, creed, ethnic origin, class or religious belief will be permitted and tolerance to others is paramount.
12. We further agree to take steps to activate a positive environmental policy
13. A process of verification and auditing relating to all aspects of conformity to the fair trade guidelines is enacted.
14. That policies are put in place in relation to Health and Safety, Education for the families of co-operative members and improved living standards.
15. That it is accepted and agreed that in forming this working relationship the main aim and objective is to assist such members of the co-operative to trade their skills and expertise in exchange for money in order to provide a better and lasting standard of living for them and their families.
16. That we enter contracts to supply renewable and reviewable annually.
17. That we promote the "fair-trade" nature of the products in the West.

This document forms the basis of all contracts with suppliers and shall be legally enforceable.
