Carbon footprint policy

Overview

Jambohut is committed to the reduction of greenhouse gasses.

Despite denials from major world governments who have their own idiosyncratic agendas there is a clear need for everyone to step up to the plate and be accountable for their own carbon footprint.

Despite working in a country other than our own we do not shy away from this obligation. By using analysis from the Carbon Trust we know that our emissions, including that of our producer partners exceeded 100 tCO₂e/yr for 2006. By the same time in 2007 we had only reduced this to 87 tCO₂e/yr. Of this figure Jambohut UK is responsible for emissions totalling 31.29 tCO₂e/yr.

This was mainly due to increased air travel combating the reductions put in place.

We must continue to work towards emission reduction coupled with forest regeneration.

Implementation, Aims and Objectives.

Our stated aim is to operate our business with a negative carbon footprint.

In order to strive towards this we shall;

1. Reduce travel to minimum levels
2. Use low energy lighting and heating
3. Compare annually our carbon footprint and be responsible for the carbon footprint of our producer partners.
4. Take all actions necessary to reduce emission of harmful greenhouse gasses.
5. Utilise recyclable and renewable sources of energy where possible.
