## Environmental policy

### Overview

Jambohut recognises and is committed to the protection of the environment.

Jambohut is a strong advocate of recycling and has and will continue to develop more products made from recycled and therefore 100% sustainable materials.

Timber and pulp products are contained with the forest product awareness and traceability policy.

As with any developing country environmental degradation appears to be concentric with its growth. Fore-knowledge of this assists us, within our own environs, in preventing it.

Developing environmental policies with producer partners is first based on an understanding of the damage done by not having one. To this end we have commenced the policy by implementing a strategy where individuals can see for themselves positive gain, i.e. cleaner local environment due to proper disposal of waste, not using hazardous chemicals, reading labels and being aware and making money from rubbish.

This will then be later extended into a full-on environmental policy where all producer groups are environmentally cognoscente.

### Implementation, Aims and Objectives.

The following shall be included in the contract with suppliers;

That in the absence of a policy in relation to **Environmental Policy** produced and approved by "the purchaser", the following shall apply:

- i] that no hazardous materials shall be used other than in strict adherence to manufacturers instructions and that use and subsequent disposal of

such shall be conducted in a proper manner so as to have to have a positive environmental impact.

- ii] that no hardwoods, specifically teak, mahogany and ebony shall be used in manufacture of new orders.
- iii] Further that if no Environmental policy exists within the workplace that one will be completed as soon as practicable and assistance by "the purchaser" shall be freely given to "the producer partner" to assist in this regard
